- I. Silva/Rothkugel vs Smith Baking Company decision – Prasad Sharma, TCA General Counsel
 - Prshad Sharma reviewed the Silva/Rothkugel vs. Smith Baking

Company decision, focusing on its implications for arbitration agreements and the classification of Independent Contractors. The case sheds light on how courts may interpret and enforce arbitration agreements within contracts for Independent Contractors, which could impact similar business relationships across various industries. Members also raised questions regarding the Werner Enterprises Supreme Court appeal and Wabash.

- II. Myth vs Truths Discussion TCA Staff
 - Hailey Manager of Government Affairs gave an update on the Myth V. Truth Subcommittee. She noted that the subcommittee decided that TCA should create an interactive leave-behind summarizing six Myths vs. Truths.
